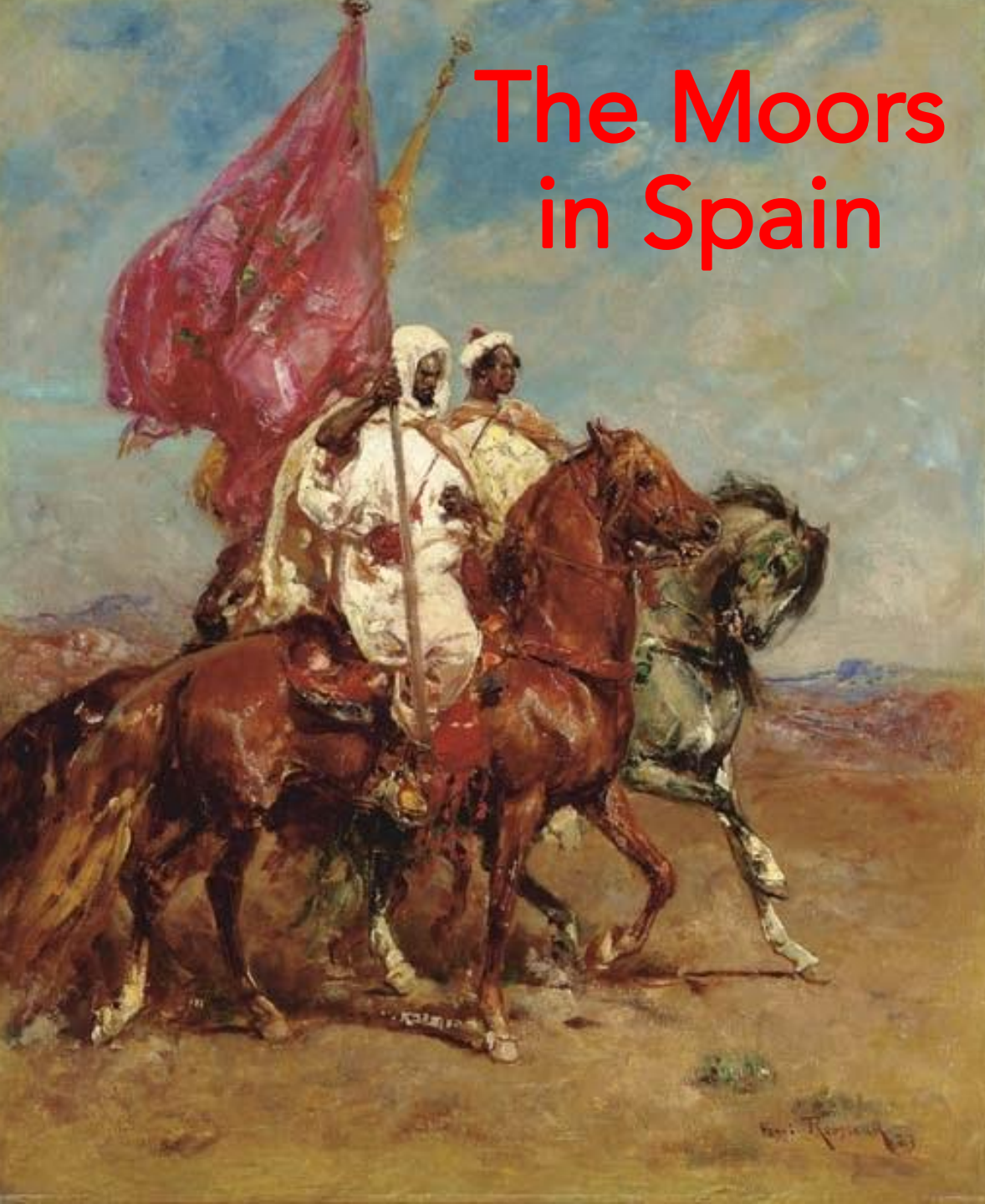

For more than 700 years — from 711 A.D. until 1492. The Moorish advances in mathematics, astronomy, art, and agriculture helped propel Europe out of the Dark Ages and into the Renaissance.

Education was universal in Moorish Spain, while in Christian Europe, 99% of the population was illiterate and even kings could neither read nor write. At the time when Europe had only two universities, the Moors had seventeen, located in Spain.



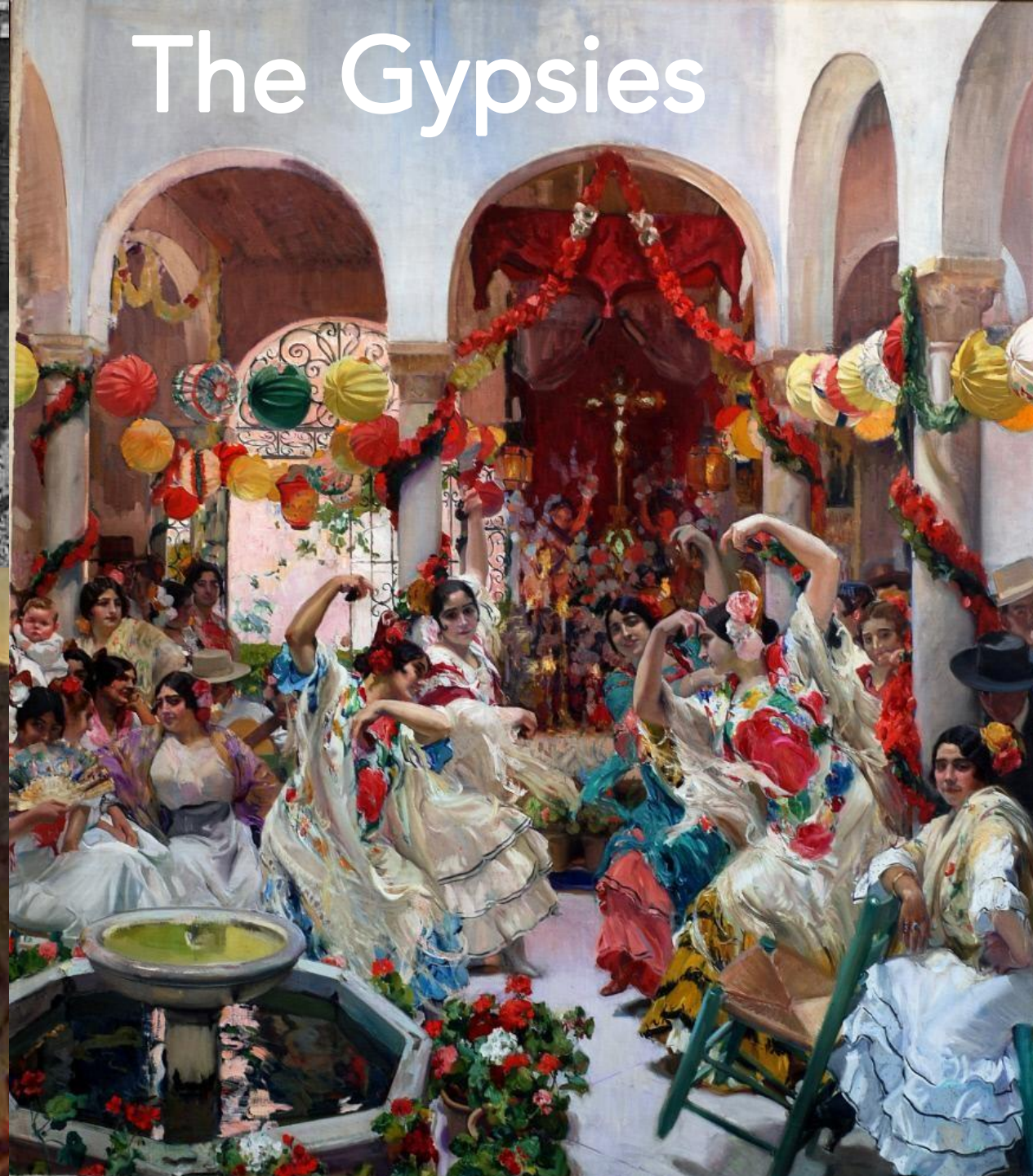
