Our programs can be offered as an arts in education program, as electives or after school activities. We also offer field trips to our professional productions at Richmond CenterStage and The Cultural Arts Center at Glen Allen.

The Latin Ballet of Virginia's mission is to "Create and strengthen connections to Hispanic/Latin American cultures through innovative and immersive dance-inspired education and performances that affect positive and sustainable change in people's lives."

Our programs strive to raise awareness and appreciation for the Hispanic/Latino culture while positively impacting people's lives. Exposure to culturally-rich experiences fosters stronger community and stimulates intellectual curiosity while celebrating diversity. Our educational programs promote cultural engagement and positively affect quality of life and educational achievement.

The Be Proud of Yourself (BPY) Programs have been recognized by the Virginia Commission for the Arts, the National Endowment, Virginians for the Arts for the Arts and the Wolf Trap Institute for Early Learning Through the Arts and include:

- **Spanish Language through Dance:** A bilingual program emphasizing the language, identity, history and culture of Hispanic countries

- **Dance as Therapy:** for children with attention deficit disorders and learning disabilities
- **English as a Second Language through Dance:** Helping those new to the United States improve language and communication skills
- **Everybody READS!:** Promoting a love for reading and literature
- **Healthy Love for Me:** Provides health education for obese and at risk children
- **Jardin VERDE (Green Garden):** Promoting love and respect for the planet through environmental awareness

Our educational programs received the **Jane Baskerville Award** for the best community education program for World Languages in Chesterfield County Public Schools, Virginia and the **Best Artists in Residency for Multicultural Programs Award**, in Cabarrus County, North Carolina. Ana Ines King and LBV also received the **2011 Theresa Pollack Award for Artists in Excellence in Dance**. These accomplishments highlight the dedication Latin Ballet has for the work it does and the community it serves. Ana Ines King recently received the 2015 Outstanding Women of the Year award in the Arts category for her commitment to arts in education and her impact in our community.
